OVERALL JOB PURPOSE

The position is responsible for ensuring the physical well-being of all the children, pupils/students and staff in the school.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- a. Develop and implement effective clinical procedures for best care for all patients.
- b. Identify and treat children and staff with various illnesses and dispense drugs as per prescription.
- c. Provide advice to school Head Teachers, Head Cook and Social Workers on issues related to nutrition and diet, hygiene, cleanliness, proper sanitation and preventive cure
- d. Support the organization in the budgeting and budget monitoring process for the activities of treatment and cure
- e. Participate in the writing of the annual work plan for the nursing unit in line with the strategic plan.
- f. Manage the process of procurement, storage and use of medical drugs and supplies/equipment.
- g. Manage the dispensary at MoHI schools/centers.
- h. Refer serious/complicated cases to other health facilities.
- i. Provide health education to the children, staff and local community.
- j. Advice management on health issues affecting children.
- k. Coordinate immunization and vaccination programmes for children
- I. Carry out guidance and counseling to children as is necessary
- m. Provide reports are required
- n. Keep proper documentation and records on diagnostics, treatment, drug purchases and dispensation and other supplies
- o. Discuss and advice parents/guardians on the medical conditions of their child
- p. Perform any other duties as may be assigned from time to time by the Supervisor.
