Celebrating 25 YEARS OF MINISTRY

This year, we celebrated 25 years of God's faithfulness. What began in the heart of Nairobi's Mathare Valley with Wallace and Mary Kamau, 50 students, two rented classrooms, and bold faith has grown far beyond what anyone could have imagined. From the beginning, the vision was clear: to share the love and hope of Christ with children and families in disadvantaged communities through education, economic empowerment, medical care, and spiritual development.

The early years were marked by sacrifice, perseverance, and daily dependence on God's provision. Support was limited, resources were few, and the journey was often uncertain. Yet God provided, sustained, and multiplied what was sown in faith. Over time, partnerships formed, programs expanded, and doors opened into new communities across Kenya and, later, Liberia and Ethiopia.

Today, students, families, and communities are being served through schools, clinics, churches, skills training, economic empowerment and discipleship. But numbers only tell part of the story. Each life represents hope restored, faith strengthened, and futures changed.







Educate CHILDREN

Our schools provide a high-quality Christian education that fosters lifelong learning and holistic transformation. Students benefit from realistic class sizes, trained teachers, and a safe, nurturing environment. Each student is connected to a social worker who supports their family's needs and links them to medical care, skills training, and business loan services. Graduates are further equipped with life skills, spiritual development, and access to higher education or vocational training programs to ensure their continued success.



2025 EDUCATION PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

New Science Labs

We opened four new science laboratories across our schools, expanding access to hands-on science education for secondary students. These labs create dedicated spaces for practical learning in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology, allowing students to move beyond theory and engage more deeply with scientific concepts. With modern equipment and purpose-built learning environments, these labs are helping prepare students for future studies and careers in science-related fields.

First Graduation in Liberia

MOHI history was made at our Kakata Center in Liberia as we celebrated our first preschool graduation outside Kenya! A total of 137 kindergarten students graduated before an enthusiastic crowd of more than 400 people. Parents, community members, and local leaders came to celebrate and witness the impact MOHI is having in their community.

First School in Ethiopia

We celebrated a significant milestone by opening our first MOHI school in Kore, Ethiopia. We are grateful for the opportunity to share our holistic model with a new community. As the school begins to take root, we are excited to see how God will use this work to share His love and hope with children and families in Kore and to open doors for long-term transformation.

Mnara Mentorship Program

MOHI's Mnara Program, our nine-month mentorship and spiritual formation initiative for high school graduates, continues to thrive. This year, over 492 graduates participated, growing in their faith, character, and leadership. We praise God that during the program, more than 85 students made commitments to follow Christ. We are grateful for the transformative work God is doing among our young adults.



From Poverty to the Practice of Law

"I look forward to giving back to society and encouraging more children that even where there seems no hope, eventually hope can be found."

Born into poverty, Jacinta was given an opportunity through MOHI that changed her future. Through education, mentorship, and faith, she grew in confidence and purpose. Jacinta pursued law, graduated from the University of Nairobi and, in 2025, became an advocate in Kenya. She now dreams of giving back and inspiring others just as she was supported.



Empower FAMILIES

Our empowerment programs equip parents and community members with practical skills to secure jobs and reliable incomes. Through the MOHI Technical Training Institute (MTTI), participants learn trades like mechanics, plumbing, sewing and culinary arts. Microfinance loans and business training inspire entrepreneurship. Sustainability projects, such as uniform manufacturing and food production, create job opportunities while fostering the organization's financial stability.



2025 EMPOWERMENT PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Leadership Development

We intentionally invested in staff and leadership development as we prepare for continued growth across the ministry. Through core teacher training, professional development workshops, and expanded leadership coaching, our staff were equipped with new skills, strengthened in their calling, and unified around MOHI's mission. These efforts ensure that as God grows the work, our leaders and staff are prepared to guide and serve with excellence.

MOHI Technical Training Institute (MTTI)

MTTI is our skills-training program that offers dozens of courses from fashion and design and catering to plumbing and welding. Since launching in Nairobi, MTTI has expanded to multiple locations across Kenya. This year, new programs began in four locations. And, overall, the program saw 1,334 students graduate. We pray the skills they've gained will strengthen their lives, families, and communities.



From Survival to Stability

"Now, I can support my family and even save for the future."

As a single mother of four, Topista faced daily uncertainty, struggling to provide food, education, and stability for her family. Through MOHI, her children now receive education, meals, and medical care, while Topista gained training and support through microfinance. Today, she runs a profitable business, is purchasing land, and looks to the future with renewed hope and confidence.





Restore HEALTH

Our health programs advance physical, mental, emotional, relational and spiritual health. Our medical and dental clinics provide accessible healthcare to our students, their families, and the communities we serve. Through our child survival program, we teach expectant and new mothers proper prenatal care and healthy nutrition for infants and toddlers. We support and empower marginalized groups to reduce discrimination and build positive relationships. We counsel those who have experienced trauma or difficulties in daily life to enable them to succeed.



2025 HEALTH PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Mabatini Clinic Launch

As part of our commitment to delivering quality, affordable healthcare, we launched a fully equipped health clinic at our Mabatini Center to serve staff, students, and neighbouring communities. The clinic provides outpatient care, laboratory services, a pharmacy, and minor surgical procedures, ensuring that community members have access to quality healthcare.

Special Needs Program

Through God's provision and the generosity of our partners, construction is underway on a six-story facility with a medical center that will provide therapy, education, and individualized care for hundreds of children with special needs while equipping parents with training and support. We praise God for the progress made and for the dignity, joy, and inclusion these programs continue to bring to our communities.

Special Olympics

More than 160 children and their families participated in our Special Olympics event, enjoying a day of inclusive games, joy, and fellowship. Each family was also given a food basket.

Shine Dance

In partnership with Christ's Church of the Valley (Peoria, AZ), over 80 children from the Baba Dogo community joined us for the Shine Dance, continuing a meaningful tradition of celebrating children living with disabilities. The day was filled with music, dancing, shared meals, and moments of genuine joy, creating a space where children and families were seen, valued, and encouraged.



From Injury to Healing

"Were it not for MOHI, I would never have been treated."

At just seven years old, a small injury left Esther in constant pain, unable to walk properly or attend school. However, MOHI social workers connected her to medical care, and MOHI covered the full cost of treatment, including surgery. Today, Esther is healed, walking comfortably, back in school, and thriving with renewed health, confidence, and hope for her future.





Igniting Spiritual Development

MOHI's Ignite Youth Conference continues to have a huge impact on our seventh- and eighth-grade students by strengthening faith, building friendships, and fostering lifelong relationships with Jesus. We hosted one of the largest Ignite events, bringing together over 1,800 students in grades 7 and 8 for an unforgettable day of inspiration and worship.

Centered on the theme "The Mighty Men of King David," the event encouraged students to rise as courageous and faithful leaders. It featured uplifting worship, joyful songs, and vibrant presentations.

2025 PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Short-Term Mission Trip Teams

This year, we were blessed to welcome and serve alongside more than 1,085 visitors on 90 short-term mission teams. These teams supported staff development, student programs, medical outreaches, sports ministry, community evangelism, VBS, home improvements, care for children with special needs, and more. Together, the impact reached over 31,400 students, families, and community members. Glory to God!

Clean Water in Kargi

In a joyful ceremony, MOHI dedicated a new water well at our Kargi Center. In partnership with Eastside Christian Church (Anaheim, CA), the team piped the water more than nine kilometers to the school. The celebration was unforgettable as children played in the clean, flowing water.

Growth in Lochoredome

Thanks to the generosity and commitment of our partners, we began construction of a new clinic that will become the first medical facility in the area, where the nearest clinic is more than 35 kilometers away. Additionally, our partners also stepped forward to support the team serving there. Through funds raised, much-needed staff housing is being constructed, providing a safe and stable place for staff to live as they care for students, families, and the surrounding community.

An Ambulance for Kargi

Through the generosity of our partners, we are thrilled to share that MOHI secured a fully equipped 4x4 medical response vehicle for the Kargi Health Center, bringing lifesaving care within reach for remote communities in northern Kenya. The vehicle supports emergency response, mobile clinics, and maternal-child health services, giving families in hard-to-reach areas faster access to critical medical care when every minute matters.

TCMI Institute Graduation

Seventeen graduates, including four MOHI staff members, proudly donned their caps and gowns during TCM's second Kenyan graduation ceremony. The graduation marked the successful completion of the graduates' four-year master's programs across different disciplines. Congratulations to all the graduates!

Fighting Malnutrition

Critical funds were raised to address malnutrition among vulnerable children and families. These gifts made it possible to provide nutritious meals, medical monitoring, and ongoing care for those most at risk, helping children grow stronger and healthier. By coming alongside families in this way, our partners play a vital role in supporting both physical well-being and long-term flourishing within the communities we serve.



Vision TO REACH MORE

We are committed to transforming even more disadvantaged communities through the love and hope of Christ, and we desire to expand, impacting additional countries and communities through education, economic empowerment, medical care and spiritual transformation. By building new schools, planting more churches, and serving through holistic ministry, we seek to break the cycle of poverty and restore hope.

College Scholarships

MOHI graduates can apply for loans to attend universities, colleges, or vocational training programs. Your gifts support this fund, which distributes loans based on need. As students repay, the funds are reinvested to help future students pursue their educational goals.



Create Entrepreneurs

Through microfinance loans and business training, we equip entrepreneurs with the resources to start and grow businesses. With a 90% loan repayment rate, funds are reinvested to empower more individuals. This process fosters confidence, breaks cycles of poverty, and strengthens families and communities, creating lasting change.



Build a School

Education is central to breaking the cycle of poverty and sustainable development. By building new schools or adding classrooms, we create more opportunities for children and families to access quality education. These construction projects are vital to supporting our growing impact and outreach.



Child Sponsorship

Sponsor a child for \$40/month and make a lasting impact. Your support provides a quality Christian education, nutritious meals, medical care, and the opportunity to hear the life-changing message of Jesus Christ.



Plant a Church

We are continually expanding to meet the spiritual needs of our communities by planting new churches. Each church is a beacon of hope, offering a place for worship, discipleship, and community. These churches help spread the Gospel and foster long-term spiritual transformation in the lives of children and their families.
